IS HAPPY WITH HIS PORTION (PIRKE AVOT)

WHOEVER SUFFERS AT FIRST SHALL ULTIMATELY FIND REST

What are the righteous compared to in this world? To a tree standing entirely in a pure place, but whose branches stretch over an impure place. Trim the branches, and the tree will be standing entirely in a pure place. So does G-d bring suffering upon the righteous here on earth so that they inherit the World-to-Come: "Though your beginning was painful, you shall ultimately flourish" (Job 8:7). (Kiddushin 40b)

This teaches that whoever suffers at first shall ultimately find rest. No one suffered more than Abraham, who was thrown into a furnace and was exiled from his father's house. Sixteen kings pursued him, he underwent ten trials, he buried Sarah. Yet ultimately he found rest.
